

**Ordinance No. 2016-019**

**Town of Ledgeview  
Brown County, Wisconsin**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 5 ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES,  
SECTION 19(C) ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT GRANTS**

The Town Board of Supervisors of the Town of Ledgeview, Brown County, Wisconsin does ordain as follows:

**Section 1:** Chapter 5, Alcoholic Beverages, Section 19(C) Economic Development Grants, of the Town of Ledgeview Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to read as follows:

**~~§5-19(C) Economic Development Grants.~~**

- ~~(1) The Town of Ledgeview hereby finds that it is in the interest of the public welfare to increase the property tax base, provide employment opportunities, attract tourists and generally enhance the economic and cultural climate of the community by providing additional economic incentives for new businesses with liquor licenses.~~
- ~~(2) After the granting of any new reserve "Class B" intoxicating liquor license and payment of the initial issuance fee of \$10,000, the applicant may file an application for an economic development grant of up to \$9,575 with the Town Clerk. One half of the total grant may be paid six months after the license is issued. The remainder may be paid one year after initial issuance.~~
- ~~(3) No grant money may be paid until the Clerk has determined that the licensee has operated in compliance with the approved license. The Clerk may obtain the assistance of any other Town office or other governmental agency in making said determination. If the Clerk determines that the licensee is so operating, the Clerk shall deliver the finding to the Town Board. If the Clerk determines that the licensee is not in compliance with the approved license, no economic development grant may be authorized, and the Clerk shall make such finding in writing and cause to be delivered a copy of the findings to the licensee. The Clerk shall also deliver the finding to the Town Board.~~
- ~~(4) If the licensee disagrees with the Clerk's determination, the licensee may file a written notice of appeal upon the Clerk within 10 calendar days of the delivery of the written notice of the Clerk's findings. Upon receiving such notice from the licensee, the Clerk shall deliver said notice to the Town Board, which shall hold a hearing thereon. The Town Board may affirm or reverse the Clerk's determination. If the Clerk's determination is upheld, appeal thereof may be taken to Circuit Court pursuant to § 753.04, Wis. Stats. If the Clerk's determination is reversed, the Town Board shall authorize the payment of the economic development grant.~~
- ~~(5) Notices and hearings for suspension or revocation proceedings may occur independent of or in conjunction with proceedings under this section but are not necessary to support a denial of an application for the economic development grant.~~

**Section 2:** Repeal of inconsistent ordinances. All existing town ordinances, parts of ordinances, and amendments thereto in conflict with any of the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

**Section 3:** Severability. If any section, clause, provision or portion of this ordinance is adjudged unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provision shall not be affected hereby.
