

Town of Ledgeview Park and Recreation Committee  
January 15, 2015

The Ledgeview Park and Recreation Committee held a meeting on January 14, 2015 at the Ledgeview Town Hall located at 3700 Dickinson Road, De Pere WI 54115.

The meeting was called to order at 6:02 p.m.

Members present were Steve Krueger, Phillip Danen, Nicole Van Helden, Larry Sidman, Jason Shanda, and Sarah Burdette (Town Clerk). Scott Brosteau (Town Engineer) in attendance for connectivity discussion.

AGENDA APPROVAL: The agenda was approved as provided.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: Motion by Sidman to approve minutes as provided, seconded by Shanda. The motion carried.

PUBLIC COMMENT: None

COMMUNICATIONS:

Welcome and introduction of Beautification Committee Members. – Joe Widi in attendance.

OLD BUSINESS:

None.

NEW BUSINESS:

1. Begin discussion of pedestrian connectivity mapping.

Scott Brosteau distributed new connectivity maps. Outlined budgeted sidewalk plans for 2015-16 including Oak Ridge Circle from South Parker Way to GV and Ledgeview Rd from GV to Creamery Rd. Discussed environmental challenges with extending sidewalk over the East River on Ledgeview Rd (between Creamery Rd and Winding Waters). Sidman asked about connections from Scray Hill Rd to Oak Ridge Circle, Dollar Rd to Dallas Ln, Hawthorne Heights Dr to Half Crown Run. Krueger asked about Kettle Creek Ct to Ridge Haven Ct. Sidman would like to see connection between south end of Meadow Sound Dr. to Euro Ln. Danen suggests exploring options with DNR for Trumpeter and Stone Silo connection. Explore environmental options to Ledgeview Rd passage across East River. The safety and condition of Dollar Road were also discussed. The committee felt that the review of Dollar Road would need to be addressed at the Town Board.

Committee requested update to maps for what exists, imminent plan to install, and future sidewalks.

2. Discuss 2015 Park Committee goals and work plan.

Very briefly discussed work plan ideas including:  
Fee In Lieu of Land Dedication  
Park shelter for Scray Hill park  
Identify/promote donor & sponsorship opportunities  
Trails and pedestrian connectivity

Burdette will prepare a handout for the next meeting. Committee members should bring other ideas.

**PARK & RECREATION PLAN:**

1. Discuss 2<sup>nd</sup> draft of the Park & Recreation Plan.  
Committee members made recommendations for changes to Proposed Park Locations. Suggested incorporating the connectivity recommendations into the Park Plan. Suggested some edits to the draft maps. Burdette noted all details.

Committee discussed the progress of the consultant and the direction the committee would like to take. Motion by Krueger to recommend to the Town Board to terminate contract with Community Planning & Consulting. Seconded by Sidman. Motion carried. Burdette will work with Town Board and consultant to address this upon action of the Town Board.

**ADJOURNMENT:** Motion by Danen, seconded by Sidman to adjourn meeting at 8:00 p.m. The motion carried unanimously.
