

Town of Ledgeview Park and Recreation Committee  
April 27, 2015

The Ledgeview Park and Recreation Committee held a meeting on April 27, 2015 at the Ledgeview Town Hall located at 3700 Dickinson Road, De Pere WI 54115.

The meeting was called to order at 6:02 p.m.

Members present were Steve Krueger, Nicole Van Helden, Larry Sidman, and Philip Danen. Jason Shanda was available via telephone. Sarah Burdette (Town Clerk/Administrator), Rebecca Ellenbecker (Town intern) and Dustin Wolff (Planning consultant from Mead & Hunt) were present.

AGENDA APPROVAL: The agenda was approved as provided.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: Motion by Sidman to approve minutes from March 23, 2015 as provided, seconded by Van Helden. The motion carried unanimously. Danen abstained.

PUBLIC COMMENT: None

COMMUNICATIONS:

1. Beautification Committee update: Committee meets tomorrow at 5:30.
2. Van Helden informed the group that Joe Widi, member of the Beautification Committee, would also like to participate in the Park Committee. The Town Board will need to appoint Widi to the Committee. An additional Park Committee member is desired and recruitment will take place. A future town board action will be needed to review and amend the committee ordinance with respect to membership.

OLD BUSINESS: None

NEW BUSINESS:

1. Discuss Resident Requests to Locate a Dog Park in the Town: Krueger informed the group that he was approached with the request for the Committee to consider the future location of a dog park. Discussion took place on location, land availability, fence requirements, sponsorship opportunities. The Committee determined that consideration for this type of park can be reviewed and discussed during the Park and Recreation Plan when future parks are reviewed.
2. Review Conceptual Preliminary Plat for The Crossing at Dollar Creek, located on Parcels D-184 and D-184-3 on Dollar Road, requested by Steve Bieda of Mau & Associates, agent for Ryan Radue of Seville Property, LLC, applicant: Committee members reviewed the conceptual map and had the following questions and comments: they would like the connection to Outlot #1 on the east side of the development to be completed with the development, consideration on the type and size of park space, potential future maintenance expenses, pathway and greenway connections are important to address, a connection to the future phase 2 would be mandatory. No action needed at this time. Staff would work with the developer and the Zoning and Planning Commission to address as the plat moves forward in the review process.

PARK & RECREATION PLAN:

1. Continue Progress and Discussion on Park & Recreation Plan update:

Wolff provided an overview of the revised draft plan, discussed the goals and objectives that were revised and obtained feedback from the committee members on them. A lengthy discussion took place on future connectivity, trails and the types of recreation opportunities that the committee would like to see included in the plan for the future of the town.

Discussion also took place on the preservation of natural spaces to protect them, to provide public access to such spaces and as a way to connect various natural features of the Town. Maps of existing and planned facilities were given brief review and will be discussed at the next meeting.

ADJOURNMENT: Motion by Danen, seconded by Van Helden to adjourn meeting at 8:15 p.m. The motion carried unanimously.
