August 11, 2015

The Ledgeview Park and Recreation Committee held a meeting on August 11, 2015 at the Ledgeview Town Hall located at 3700 Dickinson Road, De Pere WI 54115.

The meeting was called to order at 6:38 p.m.

AGENDA APPROVAL: Motion made by Peltier, seconded by Widi to approve the agenda. The motion carried unanimously.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: Motion by Peltier, seconded by Widi to approve the minutes from the June 3, 2015 and July 21, 2015 meetings. The motion carried unanimously. Van Helden abstained from action on the July 21, 2015 minutes.

PARK & RECREATION PLAN:

1. Continue Progress and Discussion on Park & Recreation Plan update:  
Wolff provided an overview of the revised draft plan and entertained feedback on the quantitative analysis of the plan, focusing on the NRPR Standards, balancing that with existing park acreage analysis for the goal of finalizing and determining an appropriate standard for park acreage needs now and into the future. A lengthy discussion took place on future connectivity, trails and the types of recreation opportunities that the committee would like to see included in the plan for the future of the town. The focus of the next meeting will be to review the existing parks to get an understanding of what else is needed in them. Simple cost analysis will also be provided to the committee at that time. The timeline for the remainder of the plan will be to identify other future amenities, assign related costs and work on the further development of the impact fee. The goal is to have the plan completed by October.
