

**NOTICE OF ADVISORY (NON-BINDING) REFERENDUM
TOWN OF LEDGEVIEW, BROWN COUNTY, WISCONSIN
NOVEMBER 8, 2016**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that at an election to be held in the Town of Ledgeview, Brown County, Wisconsin, November 8, 2016, the following proposed advisory (non-binding) referendum will be submitted to a vote of the people:

**A RESOLUTION PROVIDING AN ADVISORY (NON-BINDING)
REFERENDUM QUESTION TO SOLICIT PUBLIC INPUT REGARDING
THE FUTURE OF TOWN FACILITIES**

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Ledgeview, Brown County, Wisconsin, is considering constructing new public works, fire department and town hall facilities; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board recognizes the long-term investment of the construction of such facilities; and

WHEREAS, the answer to this question will help guide and provide direction to the Town Board as it considers future actions concerning town facilities; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board deems it desirable, and in the best interest of the town, to direct the Town Clerk to submit an advisory (non-binding) question approved by the Town Board to the electors to solicit public input at the election to be held on November 8, 2016.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Board of the Town of Ledgeview as follows:

Section 1. Referendum Election Date. The Town Clerk is hereby directed to call an advisory (non-binding) referendum question at the General Election to be held November 8, 2016, for the purpose of soliciting public input regarding the future of town facilities.

Section 2. Public Advisory (non-binding) Referendum Question. A public advisory (non-binding) question shall be submitted to the voters of the Town of Ledgeview, Brown County, Wisconsin as follows:

"Should the Town of Ledgeview, Brown County, Wisconsin, build new public works, fire department and town hall facilities at a cost of approximately \$8 million in order to support the current need and increasing growth of the town for the next 25 years?" Yes or No

Section 3. Publication and Filing. The Town Clerk is hereby directed to file this authorizing resolution or other related matters with the appropriate election officials in

accordance with applicable law.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be in full force and effective from and after its passage, approval, and publication in the manner provided by law.

The question will appear on the ballot as follows:

"Should the Town of Ledgeview, Brown County, Wisconsin, build new public works, fire department and town hall facilities at a cost of approximately \$8 million in order to support the current need and increasing growth of the town for the next 25 years?"

EXPLANATION

A "yes" vote is in favor of the advisory (non-binding) referendum question indicating support to build new public works, fire department and town hall facilities at a cost of approximately \$8 million in order to support the current need and increasing growth of the town for the next 25 years.

A "no" vote is opposed to the advisory (non-binding) referendum question indicating no support to build new public works, fire department and town hall facilities at a cost of approximately \$8 million in order to support the current need and increasing growth of the town for the next 25 years.
