

**PUBLIC HEARING ON THE PROPOSED 2016 BUDGET OF THE TOWN OF LEDGEVIEW**

**1. Call to Order.**

The Budget Public Hearing was called to order by Chairman Danen at 6:00 p.m.

**2. Explanation of Proposed 2016 Budget.**

Staff gave a brief overview of the proposed budget, highlighting Ledgeview Statistics, Expenses, Revenues, Proposed Mil Rate, Key Budget Changes, and the Cost to Homeowners. The total proposed Mil Rate is \$2.695/thousand of assessed value. The full budget report is available on the Town's website.

**3. Open Public Hearing.**

Chet Lamers, 2690 Dickinson Road – Mr. Lamers advised that he is a member of the Zoning & Planning Commission. Mr. Lamers would like to see walking path/trail connectivity funding to continue to be supported within the budget. The board advised that in the Capital Improvement Plan, a path from Euro Lane to Meadow Sound is included. Connectivity is included within the updated Park Plan which is near completion by the Park & Recreation Committee. Mr. Lamers would like to see continued to connectivity support in future budgets.

**4. Close Public Hearing.**

After three calls for public comment, no further comments were heard.

A total of 2 residents were in attendance, totaling 10 Ledgeview Electors present.

**2. Discuss and act on the total 2016 highway expenditures pursuant to Sec. 82.03(2) of Wis. Stats.**

Staff provided an overview of the total highway expenditure amount of \$ 1,549,146 for 2016 projects. The request for Elector approval is \$2,000,000 to allow for some flexibility for unexpected events or projects. There were no questions or comments from the electors.

MOTION by Ken Geurts, seconded by Mark Pansier to approve the total 2016 highway expenditures at \$2,000,000. MOTION carried in a voice vote, 10 in favor, 0 opposed.

**3. Discuss and act on the 2015 tax levy to be paid in 2016 pursuant to Sec. 60.10(1)(a) of Wis. Stats.**

MOTION by Cullen Peltier, seconded by Dan Kerkhoff to adopt the 2015 tax levy to be paid in 2016 in the amount of \$1,898,027. MOTION carried in a voice vote 10 in favor, 0 opposed.

**4. Adjournment.**

MOTION by Phil Danen, seconded by Renee Van Rossum to adjourn the Special Meeting of the Electors. No further discussion. Motion carried in a voice vote, 10 in favor, 0 opposed. Meeting adjourned at 6:11 p.m.
