REGULATIONS

1. If a property is under a lease agreement, a copy of the lease agreement signed by both parties of interest must be submitted. The term of the lease shall be expressly set forth therein.
2. The following shall be included to obtain a quarry operation permit:
 - A. Location and description of all structures within 1000ft. of the site. Any new residential structures must be included on the list.
 - B. Description of the proposed nonmetallic mining operation
 - C. A copy of the certificate of insurance including the following requirements:
 1. Not less than \$2,000,000.00 Aggregate
 2. Not less than \$1,000,000.00 per Occurance
 - D. Hours of operation
 - E. A description of the proposed horizontal and vertical limits of the nonmetallic mining operation
 - F. Names companies to be used for blasting services for the year
 - G. Primary travel routes
 - H. Measures to be taken to control dust, vibrations, noise and erosion
 - I. Shall notify the Town 24hrs. prior to a blast
 - J. A copy of all blasting and seismograph readings shall be filed with the Town

- K. An agent of the Town may enter a nonmetallic mining site with proper notice to the operator and with proper safety equipment
- L. Operator is responsible for notifying all parties of interest and the Town office 1hr. prior to a blast
- M. Shall submit a site plan for the area intended to be blasted through the duration of the permit
- N. Shall submit a site plan for the areas which will be reclaimed, berms, fencing, etc. through the duration of the permit
- O. Any other information the Town may find to be pertinent to the nonmetallic mining operation
- P. The above information and payment shall be submitted to the Town 30 days prior to expiration date
