a.	Ordinance 2016-014-An Ordinance to Amend Chapter 118 Vehicles and Traffic, Section 5-Engine Braking.	At the request of the Town, Brown County Sheriff's Department conducted a speed study of traffic on Scray Hill Road near Dickinson Rd. This study was a repeat study see if the reduced speed limit had any effect on safety concerns raised by residents in that area. Since then, a request for the installation of a "No Jake Braking" sign was made to prohibit truck traffic from Jake braking. In order to do so, an ordinance must be adopted.
