- Park and Rec Committee Update
 - January meeting cancelled due to weather
 - Middle of January there was a meeting to review a new sub-division around Dollar Creek with the developer on what should be public land. Recommendation to be given to the Town Board in February.
 - Talked about what zoning and planning is coming up so the Park and Rec can get ready.
 - Develop plan on protecting views in the Town (view shed) and ecological piece

- Public Land Demarcation Planning
 - Table for next meeting
- Lightpole Banners – existing and new
 - Public Works working with Color Tech and Temple on the faded banners
 - Next meeting we can determine how much we would like to purchase and where we would like to place the new banners
- Lightpole Holiday Lights Purchase
 - Last year we purchased Snowflakes and Wreaths
 - Current pricing:
 - Presidential Snowflake 5' - \$387 on sale
 - Wreath with ribbons on both sides - \$327 on sale
 - Power
 - If there is a wooden pole – WPS can hook up power
 - There is a labor charge from WPS (not sure the amount)
 - Pole rules
 - We have fiberglass rules identified from WPS
 - Recommendation
 - Lighted decoration on round-a-bout by East River Dr
 - Spend Up to \$9500 on holiday lights (about 24 lights)
 - Propose to put in 21 holiday lights
 - 6 – 8 on Cty Rd X
 - 11 – 13 on Dickinson
 - Order by Feb 28th to get the discount pricing
 - Depending on the cost from WPS, we will adjust the amount if needed
 - Continue with the current lights we have (presidential snowflake and wreath)
Char to check the size and go with the same size that we currently have
 - Char to check on the all poles, including round-a-bouts. Can we have brackets for the banner and the lights on one pole?
 - Motion:
 - Spend up to \$9500 on holiday lights for 21 decorations Dickinson Rd and Cty Rd X corridors. Decorations will match the designs of the presidential snowflake and wreath that was purchased for the GV corridor.
 - Motion: Nicole V. approved and Yo H. seconded it. Motion approved
