Requested that Livestock Facility Siting Review Board (“LFSRB”) review the decision by the following political subdivision:

The Town of Ledgeview denied a conditional use permit (“CUP”) approval for an expanded livestock facility to the following applicant:

A copy of the request for review is provided with this notice. For those receiving this notice through a publication, the request for review is available through the political subdivision or the LFSRB.

The LFSRB will follow these procedures in conducting its review:

1. Request a certified copy of the record of decision-making from the political subdivision. The board may delay its request for the record of decision-making to resolve jurisdictional issues.
2. Begin its review once the record is received. The record must be filed by the political subdivision within 30 days after the notice is received.
3. Review the local decision based on the evidence in the record. The Board will not hold a new hearing, accept new evidence, or allow requests for oral argument.
4. Make its decision within 60 days after it receives the certified local record. The Board may extend the deadline for good cause.

The political subdivision, the applicant or any person who resides or owns land within 2 miles of the proposed livestock facility (if not one of the aggrieved persons), may file with the Board a statement of position, postmarked no later than the following date:

Friday, May 10, 2019.

1. THE STATEMENT OF POSITION SHOULD BE LIMITED TO THE ISSUES CHALLENGED IN THE REQUEST FOR REVIEW, INCLUDING THE GROUNDS AND ARGUMENTS PRESENTED BY THE AGGRIEVED PERSON
2. THE STATEMENT SHALL NOT EXCEED TEN (8 ½" x 11") PAGES WITH A FONT NO SMALLER THAN 12 POINT.
3. THE POSITION STATEMENT, AND ANY OTHER PAPERS FILED WITH THE BOARD, SHALL INCLUDE THE DOCKET NUMBER ASSIGNED TO THIS CASE. (SEE CAPTION).


