Firefighter (Paid-on-Call; Part-Time) – “Set YOUR Sights High” With Us!

The Town of Ledgeview Fire Department is currently accepting applications for the position of Paid-On-Call Firefighter. These positions require the firefighter to respond to calls 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, when they are available to do so or when they agree to work an on-call rotation. The average time required to work these positions varies, but minimum training is required which is 8-12 hours a month. See linked detailed position description.

Roll Responsibilities:

Protect life and property by performing firefighting, emergency medical care, rescue, hazardous materials, and fire prevention duties through preparation, maintenance and response of fire department personnel, equipment, apparatus, and facilities. Firefighting and emergency medical care is highly skilled work.

Roll Requirements:

1. High School Diploma or GED
2. Certified as Firefighter I, with Firefighter II and Driver/Operator-Pumper preferred
 - We will sponsor and train key candidates.
3. Entry Level Driver Operator Required for all Drivers or CDL B with EVOC training
 - We will sponsor and train key candidates
4. Valid unencumbered Wisconsin driver’s license and safe driving record
5. Residency within a 8-mile radius from the Town Offices on Dickinson Rd. (exceptions may be given)
6. Unencumbered Criminal and civil background checks including ability to pass WI Caregiver Background Checks
7. Pass any pre-screen medical physical including drug test
8. Maintain ability to meet respiratory fit test requirements per 29 CFR 1910.134 as adopted by WI Admin Code SPS 330
9. Not encumbered by any legal device impeding response such as confinement, ankle tracking devices or similar
10. Meet or exceed minimum annual training refresher requirements

A combination of education and/or experience may be considered.



The hiring process will include a physical abilities test, oral interview, medical physical and drug test, and a pre-employment criminal background check.
